

47. **floor** \ 'flōr \ a noun
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] the part of a room upon which one stands.
*One of Amanda's chores is to sweep the kitchen **floor** every evening.*
48. **stopped** \ 'stāpt \ a verb
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] stood still : halted.
*The bus **stopped** at the corner.*
49. **face** \ 'fās \ a noun
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] the front part of the human head including the chin, mouth, nose, cheeks, eyes, and usually forehead.
*Molly's **face** bore traces of her breakfast: egg, jam, and milk.*
50. **other** \ 'əthər \ an adjective
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] being the one (as of two or more) left.
*Marge said that she didn't like this car as much as she liked the **other** one.*

*This is the recommended starting point for **Grade 3 Classroom Spelling Bees**.
 There is no rule stating that you must proceed word-for-word from this list.
 You may skip a word if you sense that the word may present a problem at your bee.*

51. **camping** \ 'kampiŋ \ a verb
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] living usually temporarily in a place of temporary shelter or outdoors especially for recreation.
*Jack is **camping** in the woods while he builds a permanent cabin.*
52. **summer** \ 'səmər \ a noun
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] the season between spring and autumn reckoned astronomically as extending from the June solstice to the September equinox.
*Paul's plans for this **summer** include hiking part of the Appalachian Trail.*
53. **phone** \ 'fōn \ a verb
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] make a call to (a person) using a device for reproducing sounds, especially articulate speech, at a distance.
*Tom's mother will **phone** his dentist to set up an appointment.
 © Darcy threatened to **phone** the police if the clown threw another water balloon at her head.*

The following word is a homonym. Inform speller that this word is a homonym and provide, without being asked by the speller to do so, the word's part of speech and definition.

54. **main** \ 'mān \ an adjective [has homonyms: *Maine, mane*]
 [no alternate pronunciation(s)] outstanding, conspicuous, or first in any respect.
*The penguins are the **main** attraction at the aquarium.*
